Dear Mr. Nault:

On Friday March 23rd the voters of Alna cast ballots on the following referendum question:

Article 3: Shall the Town of Alna's school choice policy be amended so that after June 30, 2018, all Alna K-8 resident students will have the right to attend, at public expense, any public school of the parent's choice at which the student is accepted, except that any child who is living in Alna as of June 30, 2018, and continues to live in Alna shall also continue to have the right, at public expense, to attend any public or approved private school of the parent's choice at which the student is accepted?

The affirmative, Yes, carried by a vote of 258 to 161. As per state law, this town policy change must be affirmed by the RSU Board and participant town voters. Therefore, I am transmitting this change to the RSU Board for their ratification and transmittal to the voters for final action.
